

Confidential Canine Detection in Schools



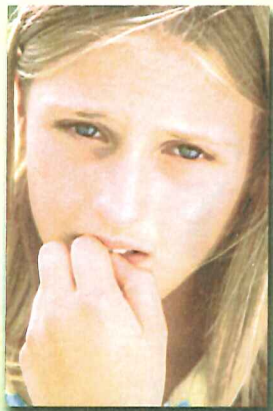
Schools are a growing concern for our children experimenting with illegal drugs. When we come to locate an odor or any drug, we will be deploying our certified narcotics K-9 to hunt around lockers, classrooms, vehicles in parking lots, and any public setting in the school. Only after the classroom is vacant will we deploy the dog to hunt for the odor of any illegal drugs. This may mean that the K-9 alerts us on a backpack, desk or another personal item left in the room. The canine will alert us to any narcotic odor where items may be or where they have been. The odor may be left on such places without actually finding anything. Perhaps the odor was left on a desk from a student's hands, or the odor was left behind with illegal drugs that were in the backpack at a previous time. When you have the surprise of the search, students will not have time to destroy or get rid of anything they may have. It is important to do random searches. This will also have them wondering when the next search will be.
